NOTIFICATION

SUBJECT: Internal Scholarships for FALL 2022

Pursuant to approval of the competent authority, following scholarships are approved for the applicant's seeking admission to CUI Abbottabad.

1. CAMS:

COMSATS Abbottabad merit scholarship is for fresh students based on the score in their prior qualification. The following programs are included:

- 1) **Bachelor of Science in Development studies.**
- 2) **Bachelor of Science in Geo Physics.**
- 3) **Bachelor of Science in Geology.**
- 4) **Bachelor of Science in Economics.**
- 5) **Bachelor of Science in Environmental Sciences.**

Fee waiver under Categories

CAT-A	50 % Tuition fee waiver
CAT-B	40 % Tuition fee waiver
CAT-C	30 % Tuition fee waiver

At the time of Admission

Eligibility criteria for CAT-A	≥ 75% marks in Intermediate or Equivalent
Eligibility criteria for CAT-B	≥ 70 %to < 75% marks in Intermediate or Equivalent
Eligibility criteria for CAT-C	≥ 65% to <70% marks in Intermediate or Equivalent

- The percentage of FA/FSc will be calculated as per the merit calculation rules of CUI where the result is awaited etc.
- Scholarship would be awarded provisionally after the completion of admission requirements by the Incharge Student Affairs.
- Incharge Student Affairs will share the verified list of CAMS awardees with Incharge Office of Development soon after the completion of Admission process and within the first three weeks after the start of semester.
- Readmitted students in 1st semester will not be eligible for the said scholarship.
- The CAMS scholarships will be merit based.
- The scholarship categories for above mentioned programs would be mentioned in the merit list so that the potential candidates can plan their admission in time.
- The candidates are required to meet the eligibility criteria as per the admission policy of CUI for these programs.

In Subsequent Semesters.

Students will be awarded CAMS scholarship as per the following criteria.

Students obtaining CGPA of ≥ 3.3 will be awarded CAT-A 50 % Tuition fee waiver
Students obtaining CGPA of ≥ 3.0 and < 3.3 will be awarded CAT-B ... 40 % Tuition fee waiver
Students obtaining CGPA of ≥ 2.7 and < 3.0 will be awarded CAT-C 30 % Tuition fee waiver

- In subsequent semesters, the list of scholarships will be prepared afresh based on the CGPA of the previous semester.
- A student freezing/withdrawal/dropping/failing a course or semester/Absent (i.e. in previous semester) the scholarship will be stopped for the current semester and resumed in the next semester after fulfilling the required conditions for the said scholarship.
- In subsequent semesters readmitted student will also be included in the competition of scholarship in the respective semester after fulfilling the required conditions of the scholarship.
- These students will only be eligible for one scholarship at a time.
- The said scholarship will not be available for any student beyond the normal duration of the program.
- The student must have registered full load of semester, and have appeared in final exam.

2. Full Tuition fee waiver:

Students (belonging to all programs of 2nd semester in undergraduate programs) securing 4.00 GPA in the previous semester will be awarded with **full tuition fee waiver** in recognition of their hard work.

The above mentioned scholarship will be subjected to the following conditions:

- In subsequent semesters, the students must secure 4.00 GPA to maintain the award.
- The above scholarship will not be available for any student beyond the normal duration of the program.
- It will be awarded to students of undergraduate programs only.
- If student fails to maintain the required GPA in the previous semester, the said scholarship will be stopped for the current semester and will be resumed on maintaining the required GPA.
- These students will only be eligible for one scholarship at a time.
- The student must have registered full load of semester, and have appeared in final exam.

3. CUI Female Merit/Need Based Scholarships:

A. Criteria for female students based on merit:

Female students from any domicile and academic board, fulfilling below mentioned criteria will be provided the following scholarships. A total of five such students will be able to avail this scholarship per semester.

- Incharge Student Affairs will share the verified list of top five female students on Merit list i.e. securing highest Grade Point (GP) with Incharge Office of Development soon after the completion of Admission process and within the first three weeks after the start of semester.

B. Criteria for female students based on need:

Financial assistance will be provided to five extremely needy female applicants seeking admission to CUI Abbottabad. The office of development shall interview and decide the eligibility of such needy students. The students must meet the basic eligibility criteria, to be admitted to any degree program. If the female students and their family are not able to support their education, then the following concession will be provided to such students:

Percentage in HSSC	Concession in tuition fees	CGPA requirement at CUI Abbottabad	No of seats
≥ 70%	100%	3	5

Above concessions for CUI Female Merit/Need Based scholarship will be awarded based on the following conditions:

- The concessions mentioned in points A and B will be admissible to the students in the first semester and may continue in subsequent semesters if the specified CGPA is maintained.
- The concessions will only be applicable to the students enrolled in undergraduate programs.
- These students will only be eligible for one scholarship at a time.
- The above scholarship will only be valid and available for the normal duration of their undergraduate degree.
- If student fails to maintain the required CGPA in the previous semester, the said scholarship will be stopped for the current semester and will be resumed on maintaining the required CGPA.
- The students must take regular course load during the semesters.

4. Top 10 Board Position Holders Scholarship:

Following criteria for top 10 position holders in the board will be applicable for each program and for each discipline.

Criteria for the scholarships

Description	Concession in Tuition fee	CGPA requirement at CUI Abbottabad in subsequent semesters
Top 10 Positions in the Board for each program and for each discipline	75%	3.3

Above concessions will be awarded based on the following conditions:

- Students will have to provide the position holder certificate issued by concerned board.
- The concessions will be admissible to the students in the first semester and may continue in subsequent semesters if the specified CGPA is maintained.
- If student fails to maintain the required CGPA in the previous semester, the said scholarship will be stopped for the current semester and will be resumed on maintaining the required CGPA.
- The concessions will only be applicable to the students enrolled in undergraduate programs.

- These students will only be eligible for one scholarship at a time.
- The above scholarship will only be valid and available for the normal duration of their undergraduate degree.
- The students must take regular course load during the semesters.

5. CAMS for Engineering:

COMSATS Abbottabad merit scholarship for Engineering Department is for fresh & top students based on following criteria.


Top 05 students in each program on merit list securing highest Grade Point (GP)	Concession in tuition fees	CGPA requirement at CUI Abbottabad in subsequent semesters	No of seats
a. Electrical Power Engineering b. Electrical Electronics Engineering c. Computer Engineering	75%	3.3	5 (each program)

The terms and conditions of the scholarship are:

- The percentage of FA/FSc will be calculated as per the merit calculation rules of CUI where the result is awaited etc.
- Scholarship would be awarded provisionally after the completion of admission requirements by the Incharge Student Affairs.
- Incharge Student Affairs will share the verified list of CAMS awardees with Incharge Office of Development soon after the completion of Admission process and within the first three weeks after the start of semester.
- Readmitted students in 1st semester will not be eligible for the said scholarship.
- In subsequent semesters, the list of scholarships will be prepared afresh based on the CGPA of the previous semester.
- A student freezing/withdrawal/dropping/failing a course or semester/Absent (i.e. in previous semester) the scholarship will be stopped for the current semester and resumed in the next semester after fulfilling the required conditions for the said scholarship.
- In subsequent semesters readmitted student will also be included in the competition of scholarship in the respective semester after fulfilling the required conditions of the scholarship.
- These students will only be eligible for one scholarship at a time.
- The said scholarship will not be available for any student beyond the normal duration of the program.
- The student must have registered full load of semester, and have appeared in final exam.

6. Scholarships for the students of Dhamtor including adjoining areas (Thai, Maira Gijra, Takia and Dottar):

CUI Abbottabad has acquired approx. 600 canal land in Dhamtor for the establishment of its new campus, keeping in view the growth of the campus and future need for more infrastructure. Keeping in view the corporate social responsibility of CUI Abbottabad, as well as to inculcate the sense of ownership among the people for the University being developed there, scholarships will be admissible for the students who want to pursue their higher education at CUI Abbottabad belonging to Dhamtor including adjoining areas (Thai, Maira Gijra, Takia and Dottar)



Criteria for applicants

At time of admission

The applicant has to mention his/her interest for availing this scholarship opportunity at the time of admission. The candidate must provide residential evidence of the mentioned localities that has been issued by a relevant Governmental body.

The applicant must meet following criteria to compete for the scholarship:

SSC or Equivalent: Marks obtained 70% or above
HSSC or Equivalent Marks obtained 60% or above

Due to limited number of scholarships, candidates who secure five top Grade points in the list (prepared for this scholarship) will be offered for the scholarship opportunity (or in the onward GP merit list, if a candidate(s) in the upper GP merit list does not join).

Concession in tuition fees	CGPA requirement at CUI Abbottabad in subsequent semesters	No of seats
50%	2.7	Top 5 students

- The applicants will be required to fulfil the merit criteria of the program applied for, and basic admission eligibility.
- Verification will be done by the Office of Development, based on the domicile of the individuals that they belong to the area mentioned above.
- The assistance will be admissible to these students in the first semester and may continue in subsequent semesters if the specified CGPA is maintained.
- The assistance will only be applicable for the undergraduate students.
- These students will only be eligible for one scholarship at a time.
- The assistance will be valid and available only for the regular duration of their undergraduate degree.
- The students must take regular course load during the semesters.

7. Merit Based Scholarship for MS and MBA:

MS and MBA students will be considered for categories based scholarship on seeking successful admission in all MS and MBA programs.

Fee waiver under Categories

CAT-A 75% Tuition fee waiver
CAT-B 50 % Tuition fee waiver
CAT-C 25 % Tuition fee waiver

At the time of Admission

Eligibility criteria for CAT-A $\geq 70\%$ Grade Point (GP) on merit list
Eligibility criteria for CAT-B $\geq 60\%$ to $< 70\%$ Grade Point (GP) on merit list
Eligibility criteria for CAT-C $\geq 50\%$ to $< 60\%$ Grade Point (GP) on merit list

- Lists for first semester will be prepared by Departmental Graduate Coordinators and sent to Incharge Graduate Office.

- Scholarship would be awarded provisionally after the completion of admission requirements. Incharge Graduate Office will share the verified list of these awardees with Incharge Office of Development soon after the completion of Admission process and within the first three weeks after the start of semester.
- This scholarship will be merit based.
- The candidates are required to meet the eligibility criteria as per the admission policy of CUI for these programs.

In Subsequent Semesters:

The above mentioned scholarship is subject to the following conditions.

- These awardees will maintain following CGPA for continuation of the scholarship in the subsequent semester.

Category	Concession	CGPA Requirement
A	75 % Tuition fee waiver	≥ 3.7
B	50 % Tuition fee waiver	≥ 3.5 & < 3.7
C	25 % Tuition fee waiver	≥ 3.3 & < 3.5

- These awardees will only be eligible for one scholarship at a time.
- The above scholarship is valid and available for normal duration of their graduate degree.
- The awardees must maintain the CGPA requirement for the continuation of the said scholarship.
- The student must have registered full load of semester, and have appeared in final exam.
- If student fails to maintain the required CGPA in the previous semester, the said scholarship will be stopped for the current semester and will be resumed on maintaining the required CGPA.
- A student freezing/withdrawal/dropping/failing a course or semester/Absent (i.e. in previous semester) the scholarship will be stopped for the current semester and resumed in the next semester after fulfilling the required conditions for the said scholarship.
- In subsequent semesters readmitted student will also be included in the competition of scholarship in the respective semester after fulfilling the required conditions of the scholarship.
- These students will only be eligible for one scholarship at a time.

8. Special Scholarship of backward areas:

10 seats will be allocated for backward area students especially students of Gilgit Baltistan and backward areas of Hazara Division (District Kala Dhaka, Battagram, Kohistan and Upper Tanawal areas (Tehsil Darband)) in the undergraduate programs of Environmental Sciences, Geo Physics, Geology, Economics, and Development studies at CUI Abbottabad Campus. 75% tuition fee waiver will be given to the students selected under this scholarship. At the time of admission, minimum eligibility is 50% marks in Intermediate.

In Subsequent Semesters.

- These awardees will maintain Minimum of 2.50 CGPA for continuation of the scholarship in the subsequent semester.
- These awardees will only be eligible for one scholarship at a time.
- The above scholarship is valid and available for normal duration of their undergraduate degree.
- The student must have registered full load of semester, and have appeared in final exam.
- The awardees must maintain the CGPA requirement for the continuation of the said scholarship.

- If student fails to maintain the required CGPA in the previous semester, the said scholarship will be stopped for the current semester and will be resumed on maintaining the required CGPA.

9. CAMNS (CUI Abbottabad Merit and Need Based Scholarship):

CAMNS (CUI Abbottabad Merit and Need Based Scholarship) scholarship will be for the meritorious/deserving students with the terms and conditions mentioned below:

- The scholarship will be applicable to the students of all programs/departments/intakes except First semester.
- The CAMNS scholarship is applicable to the students enrolled in all undergraduate programs.
- Minimum CGPA required for the said scholarship is 3.
- The scholarship will be awarded to the students facing catastrophic situation e.g. sudden death of Parent/Guardian etc.
- A total of 5 students with 100% Tuition Fee waiver would be able to avail the said scholarship per semester.
- These students will only be eligible for one scholarship at a time.
- Applicants will be shortlisted and recommended by Campus Scholarship Interview Committee.

In Subsequent Semesters:

- The CAMNS scholarship is renewable in the subsequent semesters if the awardees maintain a minimum of 3 CGPA.
 - The student must have registered full load of semester, and have appeared in final exam.
 - A student freezing/withdrawal/dropping/failing a course or semester/Absent (i.e. in previous semester) the scholarship will be stopped for the current semester and resumed in the next semester after fulfilling the required conditions for the said scholarship.
 - The above scholarship will only be valid and available for the normal duration of their undergraduate degree.
 - The said scholarship will not be available for any student beyond 8th semester.

10. CAWNS (COMSATS Assistance for Walk in Needy Students):

CAWNS (COMSATS Assistance for Walk in Needy Students) scholarship will be for the needy students with the terms and conditions mentioned below:

- The scholarship will be applicable to the students of all programs/departments/intakes except First semester.
- The CAWNS scholarship is applicable to the students enrolled in all undergraduate programs.
- Minimum CGPA required for the said scholarship is 2.
- The scholarship will be awarded to the students facing catastrophic situation e.g. sudden death of Parent/Guardian, Dread Disease faced etc.
- A total of 5 students with 100% Tuition Fee waiver would be able to avail the said scholarship per semester.
- These students will only be eligible for one scholarship at a time.
- Applicants will be shortlisted and recommended by Campus Scholarship Interview Committee.

In Subsequent Semesters:


- The CAWNS scholarship is renewable in the subsequent semesters if the awardees maintain a minimum of 2 CGPA.
- The student must have registered full load of semester, and have appeared in final exam.
- A student freezing/withdrawal/dropping/failing a course or semester/Absent (i.e. in previous semester) the scholarship will be stopped for the current semester and resumed in the next semester after fulfilling the required conditions for the said scholarship.



- The above scholarship will only be valid and available for the normal duration of their undergraduate degree.
 - The said scholarship will not be available for any student beyond 8th semester.

General Conditions:

- a. In undergraduate programs the full load of courses will be considered as a Mode of class (i.e. the number of courses studied by maximum number of student in a class).
- b. In graduate programs for first 02 semesters minimum 03 courses (09 credit hours) shall be registered & in 3rd & 4th semester minimum 02 courses or 01 course of thesis (i.e. 06 credit hours) shall be registered. For MBA program Mode of class will be applicable.
- c. Only one Internal scholarship at a time will be applicable.
- d. Scholarship one internal and one external will be allowed subject to the condition that the amount of scholarships may not exceed the full fee of the semester otherwise the internal scholarship would be reduced, and this will be ensured by accounts section that full fee may not exceed in any case.
- e. The student providing consent for adoption of one internal scholarship out of available two internal scholarships then he/she will not be reverted back in any case.
